The IAGD Mastertrack is open to any AGD member, pre-Fellows, Fellows and Masters in the AGD.

600 hours of AGD PACE
Approved Participation
& Lecture Courses

The Iowa Academy of General Dentistry will offer once again, a program that will showcase courses in at least 16 different disciplines. The 6 year program will give each participant over 600 hours (with protocol) of PACE approved continuing education credits, of which over 400 hours are participation hours. For those dentists who hold a Fellowship in the AGD, this program contains all of the requirements to achieve Mastership status.

HOW IT WORKS

Each course is four days in length from Thursday through Sunday. Each course involves an in-office assignment that is to be completed during the following six-month period and presented on the first day, Thursday, of the next session. Continuous presentation attendance yields over 100 participation hours per year, covering all of the required topics. This results in more than the necessary 400 participation hours required for Mastership at the end of a 6-year cycle.

The IAGD Mastertrack program is limited to the first 20 people who register! Don't Delay!!

On Thursday, March 16th (first Mastertrack weekend) we will hold prerequisite courses for the IAGD Mastertrack class. This will include an overview of the Mastertrack, Power Point 101, Case Presentation Overview and Digital Photography.

Each subsequent Thursday of each weekend will be case presentations. Attendance and doing a case presentation is required to obtain additional participation hours in each discipline. Protocol will be provided by the end of each session prior to case presentations. You will have approximately 6 months to prepare depending on dates.

Each subsequent weekend will have the follow the same schedule. Please allow for an extended schedule on the Saturday portion of the weekend. Add-

ing additional hours on Saturday will allow us to convene early on Sunday. It is our intent to hold as many of the Friday lectures of each weekend at the Hilton Garden Inn in Johnston. Locations will be announced prior to each session.

TUITION/FEES Fees are based on a yearly tuition fee. The fee for the entire Mastertrack is \$16,000. Yearly fees are payable the first week in January of every year. The tuition for the following years will be:

2017 - \$4,000	2020 - \$2,500
2018 - \$3,500	2021 - \$2,000
2019 - \$3,000	2022 - \$1,000

TOTAL \$16,000 for over 600 hours of quality continuing education. That almost \$27.00 credit hour. *Priceless!!*

FEES

All fees are due regardless of attendance. In the event of an emergency, every effort will be made to work with the participant. IAGD is not responsible for missed weekends. Being a part of the IAGD Mastertrack, you receive a significant discount in fees. If at any time, a participant drops out of the Mastertrack, the participant is responsible for the difference of the cost of each weekend vs what you have paid. That will be payable at the time the participant notifies the IAGD Office.

The fees for the IAGD Mastertrack are based on the current Mastership requirements set by the AGD. If the AGD would add any additional Mastership requirements, an additional fee will be applied.

Due to the nature of this course, no refunds of yearly tuition will be given. Organizers and the IAGD are not liable for any expenses incurred by participants due to missed session.
